GOTKIS

Stephen Joseph Gotkis, age 77, passed away Tuesday May 17th at St Mary's Hospital in Langhorne, PA after a long illness. Gotkis served as Chairman of the Lower Makefield Republican Party after a long career in communications engineering. Born in Troy in 1938 to Daniel and Ruth (nee Schwebel) Gotkis , Gotkis graduated Troy High School in 1955 as Salutatorian, and lettered in Track and Swimming. He attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, graduating in 1959 with a BS in Electrical Engineering and commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the US Army. While at RPI he interned at Raytheon where he worked on developing the first microwave ovens. After his active service in the Army Signal Corp concluded, he worked for RCA Radar in Moorestown, NJ, on the DEW line early warning system for the Department of Defense. This early warning system was built to detect incoming missiles over North Pole and Canada, and was in active use until its decommission in the 1990s. While employed there, he simultaneously attended University of Pennsylvania, obtaining his Masters of Science in Electrical Engineering in 1961. His Masters thesis, on radar technology was immediately classified Secret by the Department of Defense, and Gotkis worked for several weeks to declassify it, in order to obtain his degree. In 1959 he was introduced to Judith Klein, a young chemistry student, in Hartford, CT by his cousin. They married in 1963 in the Emmanuel Synagogue in Hartford by Rabbi Morris Silverman. They later moved to Long Beach CA where he embarked on satellite communications technology. His job was to build antennas. He then was hired away to work at Lockheed in Sunnyvale, CA for both commercial and defense purposes. In the late 1970s he moved back east to work General Electric Communications in Valley Forge, PA. Through series of corporate mergers, he wound up working for Lockheed Martin again -- the first company he had worked for -- and he was reassigned back to the Moorestown plant, albeit in a leadership role. His satellites found their way onto the Space Shuttle and on one occasion went to go witness the launch of a Shuttle at Cape Canaveral. After his wife's untimely death from cancer in 1993, Gotkis continued working until his early retirement in 2000. At that time, he decided to get involved with local politics in Lower Makefield township, starting as a volunteer. His talents in organisation were quickly recognised and he was increasing assigned positions of responsibility. This culminated in his unanimous election to the Chairmanship of the Lower Makefield Republican Committee. In addition he managed a number of local campaigns. Gotkis leaves behind a sister, Naomi Rotter, of Parsippany, NJ, and a sister-in-law Jane Klein Lackman of Delray, FL, four nieces and one nephew, two grandnieces and eleven grandnephews. His funeral, at Roosevelt Memorial Park in Trevoise, PA on May 18th, was conducted by Rabbi Shalom Lubin of Congregation Shaya Ahavat Torah, Parsippany, NJ.
