BRILLMAN

Nathan Brillman, M.D., died Wednesday, August 24th, at the age of 93. He grew up in Strawberry Mansion with a passion for baseball, frequently playing on the ball fields at 33rd and Dauphin Streets. He was a member of a team in the city-sponsored baseball league that took the City of Philadelphia's Championship title for 16 Year-Olds and Younger. After graduating from Simon Gratz High School in June, 1940, he worked in the accounting office of the U.S. Navy Yard until he entered the U.S. Army. He participated in the invasion of France, landing on Omaha Beach a few days after D-Day. He served in the battles of Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, Ardennes (the Battle of the Bulge), and Central Europe, and was among the first Americans to enter Berlin. He received five battle stars and was awarded a Bronze Star Medal, a Presidential Unit Citation, and a Belgian Government Fourragere. He was dis-

charged from the Army in November, 1945, with the rank of Tech Sergeant (now known as Sergeant First Class). At the time of his discharge, in Berlin, he was the Chief Non-Commissioned Officer to the Chief of Staff of the Second Armored Division. After leaving the Army, he attended Temple University High School for a summer to obtain the necessary academic credits to be eligible for college admission. He then attended the Philadelphia College of Pharmacy and Science, and graduated as a pharmacist in June, 1951. During each of his four years there, he received academic awards. After working as a pharmacist for two years, he attended Jefferson Medical College and received his M.D. degree in June, 1957. He then practiced medicine in northeast Philadelphia for 32 years, retiring in 1990. He was an avid tennis player and traveler. He and his wife traveled extensively in the U.S. and around the world. He is survived by his wife, Miriam Zevin Brillman, whom he married in 1950 after meeting her in her father's drug store, where he worked as a pharmacy intern during college. He is also survived by his children David Brillman, M.D., Judith Brillman, M.D., and Susan Naftulin, Esq.; his sons-in-law Larry Naftulin and Barton Wohl; his daughters-in-law Mary Jane Cresswell Brillman and Heather Aronson; his grandchildren Ruth, Alexander, Eve, Laura, Andrew, and David; and his step-grandchildren Devon, Daniel, Madeline, and Samantha.
