## SCHUMAN

Isadore ("Izzy," "Ted") Schuman died in his home on Sept. 20 at the age of 88. Schuman also challenged Pennsylvania's Blue Laws when he dared to sell non-prescription items in his drugstores on Sunday. At that time, virtually all non-essential items, were prohibited from sale on Sunday. While these innovations are all commonplace today, Schuman led the battle starting back in the early 1950s. His commitment to customers and lower-priced prescriptions were appreciated by community members, which led to the successful Schuman Drug chain in Pennsylvania. Schuman is also known for his many charitable contributions. For example, as an alumni of Philadelphia School of Pharmacy (now the University of Sciences in Philadelphia), he established a scholarship in honor of a friend. He also funded the Albert Einstein Medical Center to build a kitchen to serve patients and their families. He was the local Chairman of the March of Dimes. In addition, he and his wife, Rochelle, were members of the Board of Directors for the National Tay-Sachs Society and many other organizations.
