

Pennsylvania. Schuman is also known for his

many charitable contributions. For example,

as an alumni of Philadelphia School of Phar-

macy (now the University of Sciences in Phil-adelphia), he established a scholarship in

honor of a friend. He also funded the Albert

Einstein Medical Center to build a kitchen to

serve patients and their families. He was the local Chairman of the March of Dimes. In ad-
